



6. Relay cards for Events 1, 2, 15, and 16 must be submitted 45 minutes prior to the start of the session in which they are swum. There is no limit to the number of relays a team may enter. Only the top two relays from each team will be eligible for awards. Enter all relays for events 1, 2, 15, and 16 with your individual entries.

7. "FUN" Relays: Event #13, 14, 27, and 28 are the designated "FUN" relays. Relay teams will be created by the host club.

Relays will be swum as 8 and under events for boys and girls.  
Custom ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> places for relays events with only two relays per team eligible for awards.
